Grade Level: 9th – 12th

Homework

Homework when graded will be worth no more than 10% of the overall grade. It will be purposeful and relevant in the form of written/art work, study, research, or practice.

Late Work

Graded assignments may be eligible for a late submission up to two class periods after the due date. If after that time the assignment has not been completed the student may be required to finish it at an Academic Development Block.

All assignments will have a firm date of one week prior to the end of the nine weeks.

Explanation of Zeroes

The gradebook will distinguish between missing assignments (MI), incomplete assignments (I), and failure (zero correct).

Reassessment

Assignments will be valuable and meaningful. Students who have not achieved mastery (a grade of 80% or above) on a graded assignment may be offered options for academic recovery based on a process developed by the teacher.

Make-up Work

Students who are absent on the day of an assessment must be prepared to take the assessment on the day of their return to class.

Extra Credit

Limited extra credit is offered in the art courses. Extra points may be added to a test for winning Jeopardy (art content)
