#### Homework

- Homework will be posted on the board at the beginning of each class period.
- Homework will be checked and/or collected at the beginning of the class period.
- If you do not have your homework assignment with you in class, then it is considered late. Part of being prepared for class is bringing completed homework assignments to class!
- If you are absent, homework assigned prior to the absence is due the day you return.
- Homework/Practice will account for 10% of the overall grade.

#### Late Work

<u>Late work</u> (labs/classwork and homework) will be accepted for <u>full credit</u> only up until the date of the corresponding Unit Test. After the date of the corresponding unit test, there will be a 10% penalty. All late work is due before the last week of the quarter – a date will be posted in the classroom.

#### **Explanation of Zeroes**

# When viewing grade in student/parent portal, please note the following:

- When a student does not turn in an assignment, a "Mi" will be entered as the grade. Any assignment which a student receives a "Mi" for can be made up within the guidelines of the make-up work and homework policies (See above).
- If a student submitted work but received no credit for the assignment, a "0" will be entered as the grade.
- If a student is absent and excused from an assignment, an "X" will be entered as the grade, meaning the student does not have to make-up the assignment and it will not count against their overall grade.

# Reassessment

Redo Policy - Students who earn less than 75% on a unit tests will be encouraged to do the
recovery test. Assessment recovery will give students an opportunity to improve their grade by
demonstrating mastery of knowledge. In order to be eligible to retake an assessment
students must have completed all assignments for that particular unit of study.

## Make-up Work

- If a student is absent from class, it is his or her responsibility to find out what work he or she missed and then make arrangements to make-up that work.
- All work must be made up within 3 class meetings after returning. Arrangements can be made for those students with special circumstances regarding their absence.
- Students <u>must schedule a time to make-up tests and quizzes</u> after school or during a study block.
- Please see the binder/folder in the classroom for handouts and Google Classroom for make-up work.

## **Extra Credit**

Extra credit questions are built into individual assignments (tests, quizzes, etc.) No individual extra credit assignments are given.
