Homework

Homework will be assigned regularly. Most assignments will consist of reading, reviewing, or studying for upcoming assessments. Reading assigned as homework may be assessed on reading quizzes on the day the reading is due.

Late Work

Per PAHS policy, if a student does not complete an assignment, the assignment must be turned in by the next class block. If the student fails to complete the assignment in that time frame, he will be required to attend an Academic Development session after school on Wednesday from 2:30-3:15. Attendance at this session is required unless the work is completed and submitted beforehand.

Late work penalty will not exceed 20%.

Explanation of Zeroes

A Zero will be assessed if a student earns no points on an assignment. An MI will factor as a zero if a student fails to submit work.

Reassessment

Retakes will be available for select summative assessments, within a two-week period from the return of the assessment through a policy established by the teacher. Students who wish to take advantage of this opportunity must take on the personal responsibility of reflection (what went wrong?), remediation (a demonstration of practice and review), and recovery (a retake of a comparable assignment). All three parts must be completed during the two-week time frame established by the teacher.

Make-up Work

Scheduled assessments that were missed due to absence must be taken on the day of your return to class, or submitted via email on the day of the missed class, per teacher procedure. Scheduled projects and essays that were missed due to absence must be turned in on the day of your return to class. If you are absent the class before a scheduled graded assignment, you are still responsible for the assignment on its scheduled date. Therefore, it is imperative that you check **Google Classroom** or email your teacher, per teacher procedure, and come prepared for the next class period! All of your work will be available either in the teacher's email reply or on Google Classroom, so there is no excuse!

All missed work must be completed within two days of your return to class, otherwise it may not be accepted or may be accepted as late.
