Subject(s): Introduction to Culinary Careers

Grade Level: Grade Levels nine through twelve

Homework

Homework will assigned as needed. Classwork not finished in class will be assigned as homework.

Late Work

Students will have two class periods per each excused absence to make up missing work. Students will have one week to make up missing labs.

Explanation of Zeroes

The grading code MI represents a missing assignment. It is associated with a default score of zero to be replaced once the assignment has been completed during the current nine week grading period. Students who do not submit work will be assigned academic detention and the teacher will call the parent. If the student does not submit the work following the academic detention, a zero will be entered in the grade book.

Reassessment

Students will be allowed to retake written, end of unit exams. Individual lab grades and semester projects **cannot** be redone.

Students who have not been successful will be offered options based on a process developed by the teacher.

Remediation is a requirement for academic recovery and must be completed within a reasonable time period as determined by the teacher.

Make-up Work

Students will have two class periods per each excused absence to make up missing work. Students will have one week to make up missing labs.

Extra Credit

There is ample provision for make-up and redo opportunities. Students who complete the required course work do not need extra credit for successful completion of the Introduction to Culinary Careers.
