Late Work

Reassessment

Redo Policy - Students who earn less than 75% on a unit tests will be encouraged to do the recovery test. Assessment recovery will give students an opportunity to improve their grade by demonstrating mastery of knowledge. In order to be eligible to retake an assessment students must have completed all assignments for that particular unit of study

Make-up Work

Make-Up work (labs/classwork and homework) will be accepted for full credit only up until the date of the corresponding Unit Test. After the date of the corresponding unit test, there will be a 10% penalty. All late work is due before the last week of the quarter – a date will be posted in the classroom
