### Homework

**Students are not assessed on homework; however, they are expected to read for twenty (20) minutes per night in order to improve their fluency.**

### Late Work

**Students are expected to complete assignments on time, when assigned. If extenuating circumstances arise, the teacher will address these situations on a case by case basis.**

### Explanation of Zeroes

**All efforts will be made to encourage students to complete their work; if, after multiple attempts of reminders and prodding have occurred, as a last resort, zeroes will be recorded.**

### Reassessment

**This course uses specialized software which caters to students' individual needs in reading instruction. As a result, reassessment occurs continuously when students are unsuccessful.**

### Make-up Work

**Students are encouraged to take ownership of their own make-up work and should be self-advocates when they have missed anything in class. At the beginning of each class, the teacher makes an overall announcement to remind students to obtain any missed work they may need.**

### Extra Credit

**This course is designed to meet the needs of the student where they are in reading instruction; as a result, extra credit is not necessary.**
