Homework

Homework will be assigned on an 'as needed' basis.

Late Work

Students will have until the next class to complete assigned work and submit to avoid academic support consequences. Students will have two-weeks to demonstrate they have learned the material and are prepared for a redo or retake. As always, teacher discretion may be used to determine if a longer period is necessary.

Explanation of Zeroes

Zeros, in most cases, are placed in the gradebook as a reminder to students to complete or make up a missing assessment or assignment. Once complete, the zero will be replaced with an appropriate grade. Should a student fail to turn in the missing work by the announced deadline prior to the close of the grading period, the zero will remain.

Reassessment

Students will have two-weeks to demonstrate they have learned the material and are prepared for a redo or retake. As always, teacher discretion may be used to determine if a longer period is necessary.

Make-up Work

Students are expected to make up missed assignments in a timely way. It is the responsibility of the student to check with the teacher when they return to school. Work will be accepted without penalty as long as it is turned in while still on the respective unit. After that the student will receive a 10 point deduction for each unit late.
