Homework

Homework is graded on completion, not accuracy.

Late Work

If a student does not turn in homework, it must be turned in the next class period. If homework is reviewed during the class period it is due, no late assignments will be accepted.

Explanation of Zeroes

A student who has everything wrong on an assignment or who gives back a blank copy will receive a zero.

Reassessment

Assessment Recovery is a process to ensure mastery of content, thus only students who have not mastered the content of the formative assessment are eligible to retake. Students may retake an assignment within two weeks of the date on which they received feedback (and/or a grade) on that assignment. Retakes are available to students who are active learners and who participate in class. Please note that retakes are not available to students who have failed to complete missing/makeup work. Furthermore, retakes are not available to students who violate the cell policy or work on other coursework in French class.

Make-up Work

All missed work (after an absence) must be completed within a week of the student's return, unless the assignment was scheduled before the student's absence in which case it is due upon the student's return.
