Homework

Homework is purposeful and relevant to class material. It is expected to be completed.

It counts as 10% of the total grade as “Practice.”

Late Work

When late work is accepted, there will be a 10% penalty.

If an assignment is not turned in and then gone over in class, it can not be turned in late.

After an assignment as been graded and handed back, it will not be accepted late.

Explanation of Zeroes

Any work not completed will be entered as “missing”, which will calculate as a zero.

Reassessment

Opportunities for grade recovery will be in the form test corrections and/or re-takes on assignments designated by the teacher.

Students will be responsible for showing up on designated days and times in order to do corrections.

Make-up Work

In order to provide feedback for students, all make-up work should be completed within **3 days of your return** to school. Extenuating circumstances will be considered.

Once I have informed you of what it is that you need to make up, I **WILL NOT** keep after you to get the work done.

All make-up work not completed in a timely manner will be entered as “missing” (MI) in the gradebook and will be calculated as a zero.

Extra Credit

Extra credit is built-in so there will not be specific extra credit assignments to take the place of an assignment a student has chosen not to complete.
