Subject(s): Social Studies Courses

Grade Level: 9-12

Homework

Homework will consist of no more than 10% of the grade. Assignments will either preview content or reinforce classroom learning.

Late Work

Policies for making up both summative and formative assessments will be the same. Late work will be accepted up to the date of the unit test. A penalty of 10% of the value of the assignment will be assessed on late work.

Explanation of Zeroes

Academic development will be assigned if students do not voluntarily complete make up/late work. If students do not attend the assigned session, a second chance will be assigned, followed by a referral if the student still does not come to complete the work.

Any work not made up by the date of the unit test will remain a zero (with the understanding that total points are used within the categories above and most of the late assignments and homework will be worth 5, 10, or 20 points.)

Those remaining zeros represent the student's level of mastery at that time.

Reassessment

Students must earn the opportunity to retake an assessment on which they were unsuccessful by completing the appropriate remediation as assigned by the teacher.

Students may earn 100% of the test points on a retake—no deduction for trying again.

Make-up Work

Make-Up work must be turned in the next class period if a student was absent (one more class period than for students who were present) (Longer absences may require extra time as agreed on between student and teacher) Make-up work that is not turned in on time becomes late work.
