Homework

Homework assignments will be given throughout the year when applicable and appropriate. They will include, but not limited to worksheets, sketches, articles, study guides and research. If a student does not turn in homework, it must be turned in the next class period and can incur no more than a 10% penalty.

Late Work

Students may hand in work that is passed the due date with a 10% penalty for being late. Students have till the end of the grading period to hand in any late assignment. Once the grading period has ended, no late assignments will be collected and the grade will be a zero.

Explanation of Zeroes

Zeros are given when students fail to hand in work or hand in work that is not completed, whether that work is a homework assignment, class activity, project, or exam.

Reassessment

Reassessments are offered to students who feel that their original score does not reflect their understanding of the material. Students who wish to take a reassessment must first demonstrate their understanding and desire to retake an assessment by making corrections to the original assessment along with completing a relearning plan.

Make-up Work

Students are expected to make-up any missed tests or assignments by the next class period they return to school. It is the responsibility of the student to check with the teacher to see what work is missing. Times for make-up work is to be arranged between the teacher and the student. Alternative assignments can be given when lab activities and special events prohibit an opportunity for retake or redo. Students that miss the arranged redo/retake opportunity will be

assigned to an Academic Development session on Monday or Wednesday after school from 2:30 – 3:30.

Extra Credit

Extra credit will be given on a case by case basis if it is deemed necessary and applicable to the class.
