Please research and apply for your potential scholarships early so you don't miss the deadline.

#### **10x Digital Marketing Scholarship \$1,000.00**

Applicants must be high school seniors or college undergraduate students majoring (or plans to major) in a field related to digital marketing, taking at least 10

credit hours during the Fall 2019 semester. Must write a 500 word essay on the following topic: **Digital marketing trends are changing the way we market to consumers. In your opinion, which 5 digital marketing trends are paving the way for 2019 and why?** Two paragraphs of why you are deserving of this scholarship. Applicants must be high school seniors or college

#### **Andy Altman Memorial Scholarship \$1,500.00**

Applicants must have attended a Virginia Beach High School all 4 years of their high school career; have at least a 2.5 GPA; have received treatment by a physical therapist or other medical therapist as a result of an injury due to school related athletics; plan to attend a college or university within the Commonwealth of Virginia. Must submit an essay of 500 words explaining how a trainer or physical therapist has positively impacted your life; two letters of recommendation (preferably from coaches or teachers); high school transcript.

#### **Bartley T. Tuthill Memorial Scholarship \$2,000.00**

Applicant must be a resident of Virginia Beach; be a full-time student enrolled in or have been accepted to a college undergraduate level curriculum; have a 3.0 or greater GPA; demonstrate an active interest in agriculture and/or natural resource conservation/environmental protection. Must submit an official high school transcript; three references (non-family members); essay of approximately 250 words explaining "your personal interest in our environment as it related to agriculture, the purpose for which this scholarship will be used, and explain why you feel deserving of it".

#### **Bill Lawrence Memorial PTA Scholarship-Independence Middle School \$500.00**

Applicant must be a graduating senior in good standing from a VBCPS high school; have attended Independence

Middle School for a minimum of two full school years; attend an institution for higher learning; be in need of financial assistance; have a minimum of a B (3.0) grade point average; earned a leadership position(s) in school and community activities; have extensive service to school and community. Must complete and submit personal information sheet (typed and signed); essay (typed); official high school transcript; three letters of recommendation (one from a high school teacher, one from a person related to your community involvement, and one from a person of your choosing).

**Charlie Benson Scholarship-Brookwood Elementary School \$500.00**

Applicants must be a June 2019 graduate of a Virginia Beach City high school and previously attended Brookwood Elementary School for a minimum of two years; have a GPA of 2.5 or higher. Must prepare and submit a 200 words or less essay on why this scholarship would be helpful to you; and submit a high school transcript and two letters of recommendations

**Cynthia Pridmore Virginia Dare Soil and Water Conservation Scholarship \$1,500.00**

Applicants must be a student in the city of Chesapeake or Virginia Beach; reside or attend schools in either city; attend or reside within the Virginia Dare Soil and Water Conservation District (Virginia Beach, Chesapeake); have a 2.5 or greater GPA or appropriate equivalent of individual scholastic achievement. Must submit most recent official high school transcript.

**Donald Clement PTA Scholarship \$1,000.00**

Applicants must be a senior in good standing, as outlined in the Virginia Beach code of conduct, at any accredited high school and must have been accepted to and accredited college, university, or vocational training school; have a 2.0 or better GPA. Must submit an official high school transcript; two letters or recommendation.

**Elementary PTA Pamela Livingston Scholarship-Woodstock Elementary PTA \$500.00**

Applicants must be a June 2019 high school graduate; have attended Woodstock Elementary School for a

minimum of two full years; acceptance and entrance to an accredited college, university or technical school for the Fall of 2019; must be a foster child or from a single parent household. Must submit two letters of recommendations; an official copy of high school transcript; a two page essay.

**Hunter Cole Berns Memorial Scholarship-Princess Anne High School \$1,000.00**

Applicants must be Princess Anne High School senior graduating this year or graduate of the last three years; be in good academic standing; plan to attend a college or vocational school next year. Must submit a statement/essay describing your involvement in special education and how it has impacted you and your decisions for your future; two letters of reference, one must be from West Building Teacher or staff member; include a copy of high school transcript.

**PAHS Booster Club Scholarship \$500.00**

Applicants must be senior who lettered in a varsity, JV, or club sport for a minimum of 2 years at Princess Anne High School (includes all team members, managers and trainers); applicants family must be current dues paying Booster Club members; be in good academic standing with a minimum GPA of 2.0; plan to attend a college or vocational program next year. Must submit a maximum 250 word, typed statement stating how participation in a particular sport has made a positive impact on your life or choose any one of the following qualities and state how it has made a positive impact on you and your teammates: sportsmanship, teamwork, character, leadership or work ethic; include a letter of reference from a PAHS coach you have lettered from; a copy of high school transcript and typed resume (include teams you played, general leadership positions, jobs held, and awards received).

**Princess Anne Elementary School PTA Scholarship \$500.00 or more**

Applicants must be graduating senior in good standing in any high school; have enrolled at Princess Anne Elementary for a minimum of two years; currently have an overall high school GPA of 3.0 or better; by the fall of 2019 the recipient must enter an accredited college or

university as a full-time student. Applicants must include verification of college acceptance for the school year 2019-2020; two letters of recommendations, the first letter should be from a teacher or counselor at the student's high school, the second should be from a person directly involved with the student in their extracurricular activities; write a 500 word essay that highlights a single, unique aspect of their life and experiences; copy of high school transcript.

Applicants must be high school senior or college undergraduate student majoring (or plans to major) in a field related to business, sustainability or marketing, taking at least 10 credit hours during the Fall 2019 semester. Must write an essay that details your interests, experience and goals related to the advancement on sustainability.

**The Delores Delaney Scholarship                     \$500.00**

Applicants must be a graduating high school senior from each Virginia Beach High School. Must submit proof of

PTSA membership (copy of 2018-2019 membership card); high school transcript; two professional recommendation letters, one from a current counselor/teacher and the other from a non-relative professional/community leader; resume highlighting your involvement in school and community, as well as achievements; heat shot photography, preferably senior cap and gown picture if available; essay explaining "Why should you be the recipient of a Virginia Beach Council of PTAs Scholarship"?

**Thoroughgood Elementary PTA Scholarship     \$500.00**

Applicant must be a grading senior in good standing; currently enrolled in a Virginia Beach City Public School; have attended Thoroughgood Elementary School for at least two full academic years; have a minimum GPA of 2.5; be enrolled in an accredited college or university as a full-time student.

**Towne Realty Foundation Scholastic Achievement Scholarship     \$5,000.00**

Applicants must be public high school student whose parents or legal guardian(s) are Active Duty Military Service Members in any of the branches based in Southeastern Virginia. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior from a Virginia Beach High School; show proof of PTSA membership (copy of 2018-2019 membership card); an official high school transcript; two professional recommendation letters, one from a current counselor/teacher and the other from a non-relative professional/community leader; resume highlighting your involvement in school and community, as well as achievements; heat shot photograph (preferably senior cap and gown picture if available); essay stating "Why should you be the recipient of a Virginia Beach Council of PTAs Scholarship?"

**Windsor Woods Elementary School PTA Scholarship**  
\$1,000.00

Applicant must have attended Windsor Woods for at least two complete school years; be a graduating senior in good standing at a Virginia Beach City Public School; have an overall GPA of at least 2.5; submit a 150-word essay describing college and future plans; include a recommendation from two teachers; include a copy of his or her high school transcript (including work in progress); be planning to enter a college, university, or vocational institute as a full-time student by September 2019.

**Woodstock Elementary Sandra Rosenberg Scholarship**  
\$500.00

Applicants must be a graduating high school senior who has attended Woodstock Elementary School for at least 3 years. Must submit two letters of recommendations, which attest to his or her academic performance, extracurricular activities, work ethic, character, and/or good conduct; an official copy of the applicants high school transcript along with SAT and ACT scores; a two-page essay. **Deadline 05/10/2019**
